About the Speaker and Presentation:

In 1991, Mr. Drescher received his Bachelor of Arts degree in History and a Thematic Minor in "Mexico Today," from Colorado College. At Colorado College he was a two-time Team Captain and MVP of the Varsity Baseball Team. In 1994, he received his Juris Doctorate from Pepperdine University School of Law, and was admitted to the California State Bar. He was subsequently admitted to the Colorado State Bar in 1997.

Mr. Drescher joined the Ventura County District Attorney's Office in 1994, and was assigned to the misdemeanor unit. In 1995, after just one year in the office, he was recognized and named an Employee of the Year. After handling hundreds of DUI cases and gaining trial experience he was assigned to the Family Protection Unit to prosecute domestic violence cases.

From 1997 to 2007, Mr. Drescher acquired vast prosecutorial experience by serving in the following units of the office: Writs, Appeals and Training, Major Crimes, General Felony, and Serious and Violent Felonies. During this time, Mr. Drescher handled and tried some of the most serious cases in the office, from capital murder to vehicular manslaughter. In 2000, he was promoted to the position of Senior Attorney, and in 2007 he was awarded the Ellie Liston Crime Victims Assistance Award.

He currently supervises the Major Fraud Unit of the District Attorney's Office. He will speak about the various crimes committed in Ventura County that the Major Fraud Unit investigates and prosecutes.
